- **IMPORTANT:** If you wish to extend your stay to take advantage of the 2 pre/post rate days, please make your reservation online using your <u>dedicated link</u> for June 11 &/or 12, 2025. Then send an email to: <u>group.vail@hyatt.com</u> to extend your stay. You will need to provide your **reservation number** and the dates for the extension (up to 2 days before or 2 days after the 11th &/or 12th).
- **Prices**: The Grand Hyatt has a special block of rooms for 6/9/2025-6/14/2025 as follows:

o 1 King: \$209 up to 2 people

o 2 Queens: \$234 up to 2 people

2 Queens: \$259/\$289 for Triple/Quad occupancy

Reservations need to be made by May 21, 2025 to get this rate. This is a GREAT deal. The rate is good for 2 days prior to, and 2 days after the convention. There are a lot of free activities at the Hyatt & in Vail, as well as options for paid tours & activities. A tour of the Betty Ford Alpine Gardens is free to all those registered with us for the conference. CFGC is paying to lower the costs of food, the entire cost for a tour, workshops, speakers, as well as the usual convention costs to provide better value to our members and guests.

- Workshops: Convention includes workshops on Day 1 (June 11) and Day 2 (June 12).
- **Day 1**: Pre-convention Exec. Board meeting, workshops, and the Betty Ford Alpine Garden Tour. Optional Learn to Fly Fish Casting Activity (Casting & Cocktails) for a small fee.
- Day 2: Business meeting (morning), speakers, workshops, cocktail reception, banquet dinner, and installations.
